Scholarships may not exceed \$ 500 and will be awarded to students entering 9th through 12th grades and teachers with fewer than three years' experience. **Applicants must demonstrate a financial need and must write no more than 500 words to explain how this training will help them as a journalist or as an adviser and why they need the assistance.**

Include with your application:

- Transcript through first semester of this year
 - A statement detailing your need for this scholarship.
 - A statement of your journalism accomplishments.
 - A recommendation from your journalism adviser
- Finalists will be notified by email and scheduled for a 10-15 minute interview at the SCJEA Write-offs, **March 16, at Long Beach Community College, Liberal Arts Campus, 4271 Clark Ave, Long Beach, CA 90808**. Interview times will be assigned between 12-3 p.m.
